When he went home, he found all the animals that he had helped.

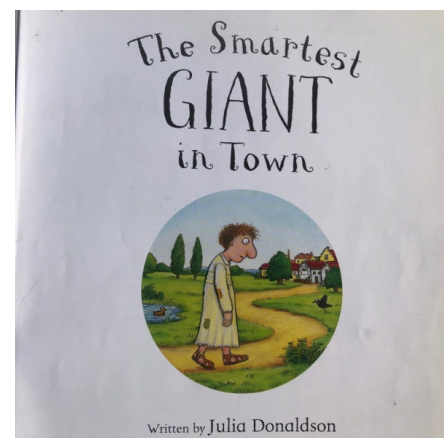
They gave him a big **present**: a beautiful gold paper **crown** and a card.
