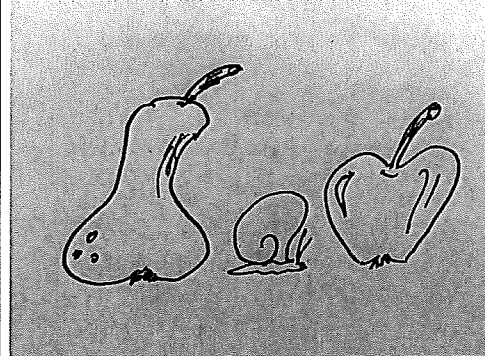
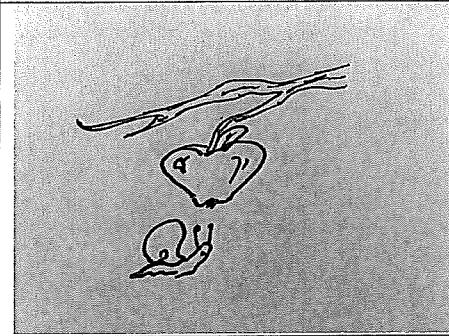


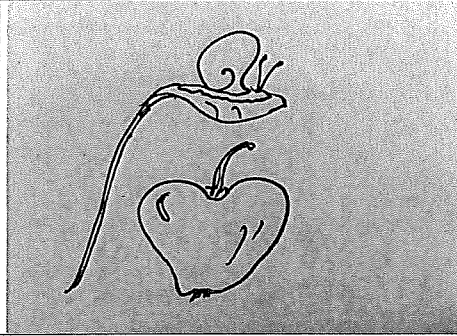
The snail is **on** the apple.



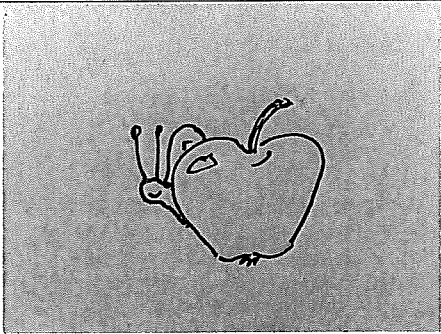
The snail is **between** the apple and the pear.



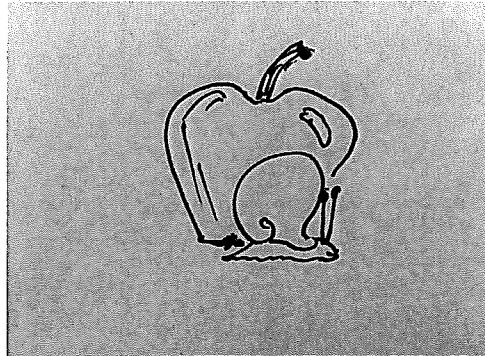
The snail is **below** the apple.



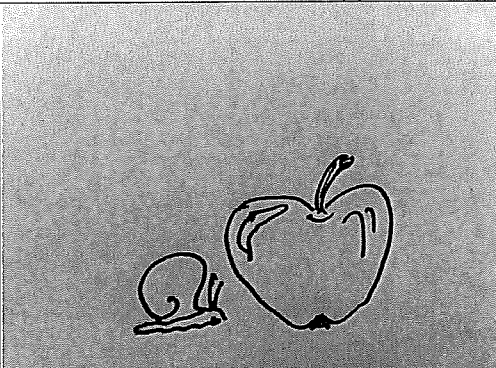
The snail is **above** the apple.



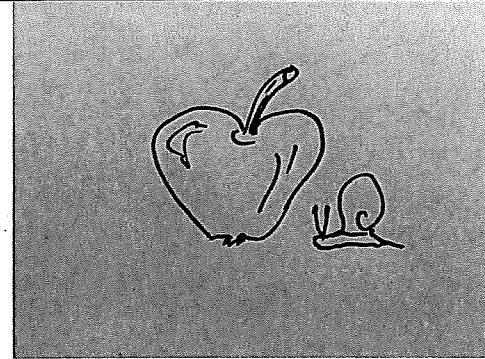
The snail is **behind** the apple.

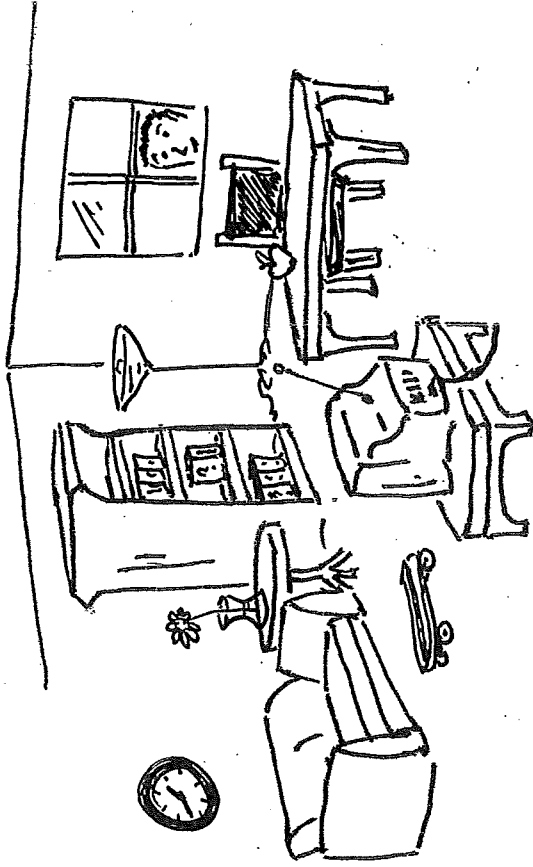
